## Research

This research examines the distribution and the quality of facilities and social services in the city of Kazan with the purpose of evaluating the degree of its accessibility for the inhabitants, and of being able to take decisions to improve them in the future.

To do this we

- have listed all of the facilities possible in the city,
- have studied the standards that the Russian government has defined in relation to them,
- have represented the facilities on the map of the city of Kazan.

The analysis has been developed at the multiscale level, that is to say, we were analyzing the facilities of

- the neighborhood
- the district
- the city levels.

Also this study has analyzed the quality of the design of the equipment and parks, comparing them with those of Moscow and Barcelona.

The result is a series of more than **100 graphics** that reveals that

- Kazan is a city relatively well-equipped city at the level of neighborhoods,
- the equipment and social services that project Kazan to the world are very concentrated in the central area of the city,
- the quality of the architecture of the facilities are of a low quality, while the parks and public gardens could be comparable to other major cities of the world.

Kazan is the capital and largest city of the Republic of Tatarstan, Russia. With a population of 1,143,535, it is the eighth most populous city in Russia. Kazan lies at the confluence of the Volga and Kazanka Rivers in European Russia. The Kazan Kremlin is a World Heritage Site.

In April 2009, the Russian Patent Office granted Kazan the right to brand itself as the «Third Capital» of Russia. In 2009 it was chosen as the «Sports capital of Russia» and it still is referred to as such. The city hosted the 2013 Summer Universiade, 2014 World Fencing Championships, the 2015 World Aquatics Championships, and is one of the host cities for the 2017 FIFA Confederations Cup and the 2018 FIFA World Cup. In 2015, Kazan was visited by 2.1 million tourists, which is a 20% increase in comparison with 2014. The Kazan Kremlin was visited by 1.5 million tourists in 2015, and the city's hotel and entertainment complex with an aquapark called «Kazan Riviera» was visited by 1 million tourists.

The main task of hospitals is to provide medical care in cases when treatment or complex diagnostic studies are not possible in outpatient and outpatient settings; if the recovery or improvement in the patient's condition can be achieved more quickly in the hospital than with outpatient treatment; If the stay of a sick home is a threat to others.



**Parks of general use** - available to all city residents and visitors plantations, rotecting from dust, excessive solar radiation, creating comfortable conditions for short-term and long-term rest, physical education and sports, cultural and educational and entertaining events. They include parks of culture and recreation (city-wide, district), children's, sports parks (stadiums), parks of quiet rest and walks, gardens of residential areas and neighborhoods, squares, boulevards, green stripes along the streets and embankments, green areas with city-wide shopping and administrative centers , forest parks, etc.(11)

**City parks** of culture and recreation - object of landscape architecture, which provides a recreational zone, an amusement zone and a service zone. (3) Parks and gardens in residential areas - object of landscape architecture, which provides a recreational area for short-term and long-term rest. (3)

**Boulevards, squares, street's plants, embankments** - green areas of the city, pedestrian green spaces along (usually in the midst of) the street (originally - on the site of the former city ramparts), along the riverbank, the sea designed for walks.(11)

**Parklands** - protective forest plantations in the form of rows of trees and shrubs created among arable land, in pastures, in gardens, along irrigation and navigable canals, railways and highways, along ravine ravines, on slopes, etc. (11)

**Parks of limited use** – green areas for outdoor activities in physical culture and sports, for classes in special subjects and children's games, medical and preventive procedures, rest in between work breaks. They include green areas in residential areas of neighborhoods and quarters, plantations in the territories of children's and educational institutions, sports and cultural and educational institutions, public and health institutions, research institutions, sanitary territories of harmless industrial enterprises. (11)

**Conservancy area** - site of land territory or water area completely excluded from economic activities of a person, in which the genetic fund of plant and animal life is preserved, and also the natural course of natural processes and phenomena is studied; the main category of specially protected natural areas of Russia and a number of neighboring countries.(11)

**Parks of special purpose** – green areas that are created to reduce the adverse impact of industry and transport on the environment. They include plantings along streets, highways and in areas, plantation of communal and storage areas and sanitary protection zones, botanical, zoological gardens and parks, exhibitions, plantings of windproof, water and health significance, fire plantations, plantations for reclamation, nurseries, greenhouse farms, plantations of cemeteries and crematoria. (11)

## Specialized parks (children's, sports, zoological, etc.) - parks, which

are designed to meet the needs of all categories of urban residents in a variety of recreation.(11)

**Sport open stadiums** - a large field with treadmills around and places for spectators, located step-by-step around the field. It also contains additional areas and ancillary facilities for training and changing teams. Stadiums are used not only for various sports in the open air (for example, athletics and football), but also for concerts and other events. (11)

Green spaces of protective and sanitary areas - green areas that are created to reduce the adverse impact of industry and transport on the environment.

**Botanical and zoological gardens** - green areas that are created on the basis of a specialized landscape environment, subject to the availability of a collection of animals and plants fo demonstrating to the population various species of fauna and flora, conducting research and cultural and educational activities for the protection of nature and wildlife. (11) **Cemetery, crematorium** – green site specially intended for burial of the dead or their ashes after cremation. (11)

## Scheme of green areas of kindergardens proximity zones in Kazan on 2017 year





**Library** is an information, cultural, educational organization or structural subdivision of the organization that has an organized fund of documents and provides them for temporary use to individuals and legal entities.(16) Full-text information resources, access to which the library receives for free, include:

- funds of the National Electronic Library, which unites the funds of public libraries of Russia at the federal, regional, municipal level, libraries of scientific and educational institutions, as well as rights holders. The NEA includes: a catalog of all the editions kept in the collections of Russian libraries; a centralized, daily updated archive of digitized publications, both publicly accessible and limited by copyright; - The funds of the Presidential Library. (16)

**The museum** is a non-profit cultural institution created by the owner for storing, studying and publicly introducing museum items and museum collections included in the Museum Fund of the Russian Federation, as well as for achieving other goals defined by this Federal Law;(17)

The object of the local history museum is the documentation and presentation of the historical, natural and cultural development of a certain locality or geographical region. The main funds of such a museum are the exhibits related to the history of the region, among which there may be, for example, archaeological finds; works of art or craft; documents and visual materials that record the historical events of the area; Houseware; Memorial items associated with famous countrymen; materials reflecting the economic and technical development of the region. On the implementation of

methodological recommendations to the subjects of the Russian Federation and local self-government bodies on the development of a network of cultural organizations and the provision of services to the services of cultural organizations (17)

**The theater** is an organization that carries out theatrical activities in order to satisfy and form the spiritual needs of the audience in theatrical art, as well as the development of theatrical art, which provides for the expansion of the accessibility of theatrical art to various groups of the population. For the network unit are accepted theaters (theater-studios), which are legal entities, or branches of theaters. Considered as a single network unit theater, which operates several theatrical companies (working in different languages or having an independent repertoire), united by a common administration and representing a unified

balance. If there are theaters of different genre orientation working on one theatrical site, they are independent legal entities, then each of them is counted as an independent network unit.(18)

The minimum list of subspecies of theaters is drama theaters, musical theaters, young spectator theaters, puppet theaters and theaters by kinds of arts. The musical theater, which includes such genre scenes as opera, ballet, operetta, musical, is recommended to create if there is an educational institution in the territory of the constituent entity of the Russian Federation that produces relevant performers (conservatory or other specialized university or college). Other theaters by kinds of arts (pantomime, miniatures, dance, songs, etc.) or by target group (youth theater, children's theater) are created in order to ensure the accessibility of the population to various genres of theatrical art.(18)

**A concert organization** is an organization that implements the creation, display (public performance), and (or) the organization of a concert program. Concert organizations include:

**Philharmonic** - the main kind of concert organization in the field of academic music, which has at its disposal one or several philharmonic concert halls and (or) creative groups, and organizing tours of other creative groups of philharmonic orientation (orchestras, choirs, ensembles); Philharmonic Concert Hall - a special venue that meets the acoustic standards for the performance of academic music, or a kind of concert organization that performs the functions of forming and satisfying social needs in academic musical art;

independent concert groups that are legal entities. Concert groups include symphony orchestras, orchestras of folk, wind instruments, choral chapels, folk choirs, choreographic and folklore ensembles, etc. (19)

**Circus** is a generalized name of all kinds of entertainment numbers, attractions, programs, performances, solved by means of circus expressiveness, and also as a special spectacular structure with a dome-shaped cover and an arena designed to create and (or) display circus works.(20)










# Scheme of theaters proximity zones in Kazan on 2017 year



## Scale of facilities in Kazan on 2017 year





## Proposition of the pedestrian availability of children polyclinics in Kazan on 2017



### **Park facilities**

There is a shortage of local daily parks in proximity radius. Aviostroitelny, Kirov, Privolzhsky and Soviet districts are almost not provided such local parks (2-8%). Moscow and Novosavinovsky are low-income (less than 50%), Vakhitov district is provided

enough local parks (60%).

### **Educational facilities**

The number of kindergartens and schools is above the average in all city areas (60-90 percent), but there is lack of their in the suburbs (villages).

### **Sport** facilities

Currently Kazan is well provided with different types of sport centers. But most of the centers have city or district scale. There is lack of sport centers in Moskovskyi and Kirov districts. Generally there are not enough local sport centers to provide citizens with sports facilities in pedestrian accessibility.

### **Trade facilities**

The Kazan provided with trade facilities almost equally spaced between district but mostly the trade facilities are located near the residential areas that are concentrated in Moskovskyi, Novo-Savinovskyi and Sovetsky district. The markets square are concentrated respectively in these districts as well. But there are lack of the of market squares at local scale for Kazan city in general.

### **Cultural facilities**

The Kazan has well developed cultural facilities at the city scale. A large number of museums, theaters and concert halls, which, however, are mainly located in the central part of the city. Local facilities libraries and cultural centers serve a small part of the population in pedestrian accessibility. Soviet, Aviostroitelny, Kirov and Privolzhsky are almost not serviced by local facilities from 0 to 11%. Vakhitovsky Moscow and Novosavinovsky are serviced in part from 9 to 37%.

### **Healthcare facilities**

Polyclinics are one of the main facilites, which serve citizens on an everyday basis. According to Russian standards, the proximity radius of the polyclinic is 1000 meters, which does not correspond to pedestrian accessibility.

Applying to the existing Kazan adult polyclinics a proximity radius of 500 meters, which corresponds to the international standards of pedestrian accessibility, we can draw the following conclusions:

Novo-Savinovsky, Moskovsky and Vakhitovsky districts are most provided with adult polyclinics, their security is equal to 40, 38 and 31 percent, respectively, at the same time the most unsecured areas are the Aviastroitelnyi, Privolzhsky and Sovetsky districts with 13, 17 and 22% respectively.

Applying to the existing Kazan children's polyclinics a proximity radius of 500 meters, which corresponds to the international standards of pedestrian accessibility, we can draw the following conclusions:

The Moskovskiy, Novo-Savinovsky and Privolzhsky districts are most provided with children's polyclinics, their availability is 46,24 and 20 percent, respectively, at the same time the most unsecured areas are Vakhitovsky, Aviastroitelny and Kirovsky districts with the percentage of availability equal to 6, 9 and 10% respectively.
